

INSTRUCTORS

The instructors role is to develop and deliver effective training to candidates. Instructors must use the course materials accredited for the centre they are instructing at.

Instructors are required for our Drilling Well Control and Well Intervention Pressure Control (WIPC) programmes at level 2, 3 and 4.

REQUIREMENTS



To instruct a level 2 programme it is mandatory for applicants to hold a minimum level 3 certification. To instruct a level 3 and/or 4 programme it is mandatory for applicants to hold a minimum level 4 certification. At least 90% in each of the assessments must be achieved.

Applicants must also meet one of the following requirements:



A minimum of 2 years field experience in a supervisory role. For WIPC, experience as a Wireline Wellsite Supervisor, Coiled Tubing Wellsite Supervisor or Snubbing Wellsite Supervisor is required. For Drilling Well Control, experience as a Driller, Toolpusher or Wellsite Engineer is required.



A Bachelor of Science degree in a relevant subject and at least one year field experience in a role which requires a current IWCF level 3 or level 4 certificate.



A relevant vocational qualification and at least one year field experience in a role which requires a current IWCF level 3 or level 4 certificate.

TRAIN THE TRAINER

All instructors must hold a recognised training/teaching qualification. IWCF offer the Train the Trainer course for instructors:

Our Train the Trainer course will enable instructors to teach effectively and confidently in the classroom, helping them to develop effective training materials and techniques that meet the course objectives and needs of learners.

Train the Trainer is endorsed internationally by ILM and fulfils the requirements for IWCF instructors. Costs are £900 / €1,080 /\$1,350.
